

Make your VRA prescription maps in MapCalc or MapInfo - then import them into JD Office and write to a card for JD's in-cab display.

1. In JD Office create a field boundary for the current year for the field you want to make a prescription for (if you do not already have one): **Data - Create Field Boundaries**. Or, import one using JD Office Boundary Tool (see www.ksagresearch.com homepage for the link to this).
2. In MapCalc once you are satisfied with your prescription map: **File - Export - Regions - DeSelect All - Select (click on) Layer to Export - OK - Save**.
3. In JD Office: **File - Import - Management Zones - Shapefiles** - (select the file you just saved in step #2) - **Message 281 click Yes - Select the target field - Next - Set Classification Description Attribute - Next - New Name - Ok - Next - Import Successful - Ok**.
4. In JD Office go to Maps - Field Maps - choose the field you are making a prescription for then go to **Setup - Management Zone to Rate Table - choose appropriate Classification** (file you saved in step #3), **Operation Type, Product Type, etc. - Copy all --> Rate - OK**.
5. In Layers window: **Add - New Application Plan - OK** - fill in Name, Category, Type, etc. - **Check Create from Management Zone Map - Ok** (Should see this layer now in your map window)
6. Write this prescription to pc card by **clicking on Rx** in the menu icons.
